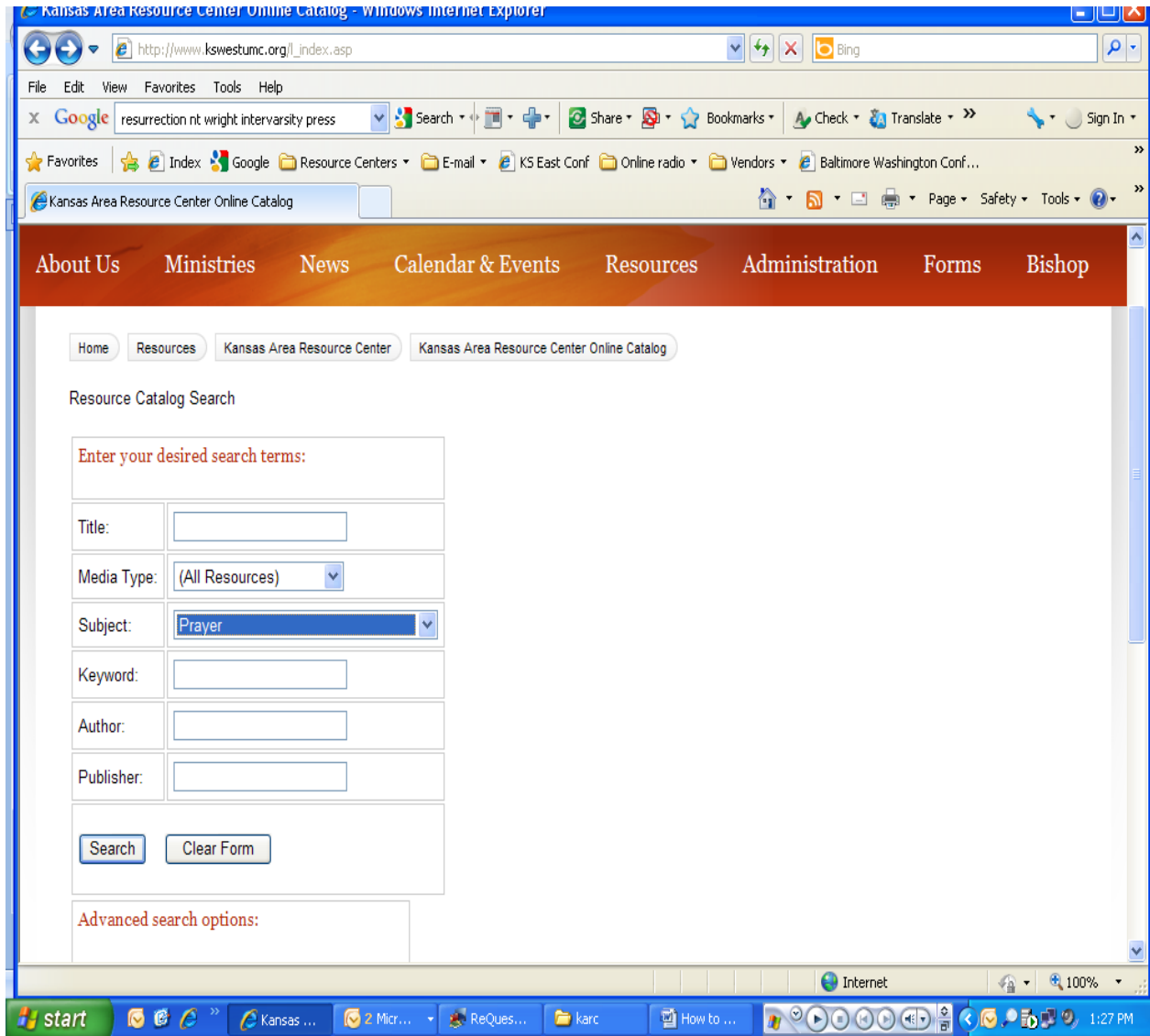


**Directions for Use of the
Online Catalog**

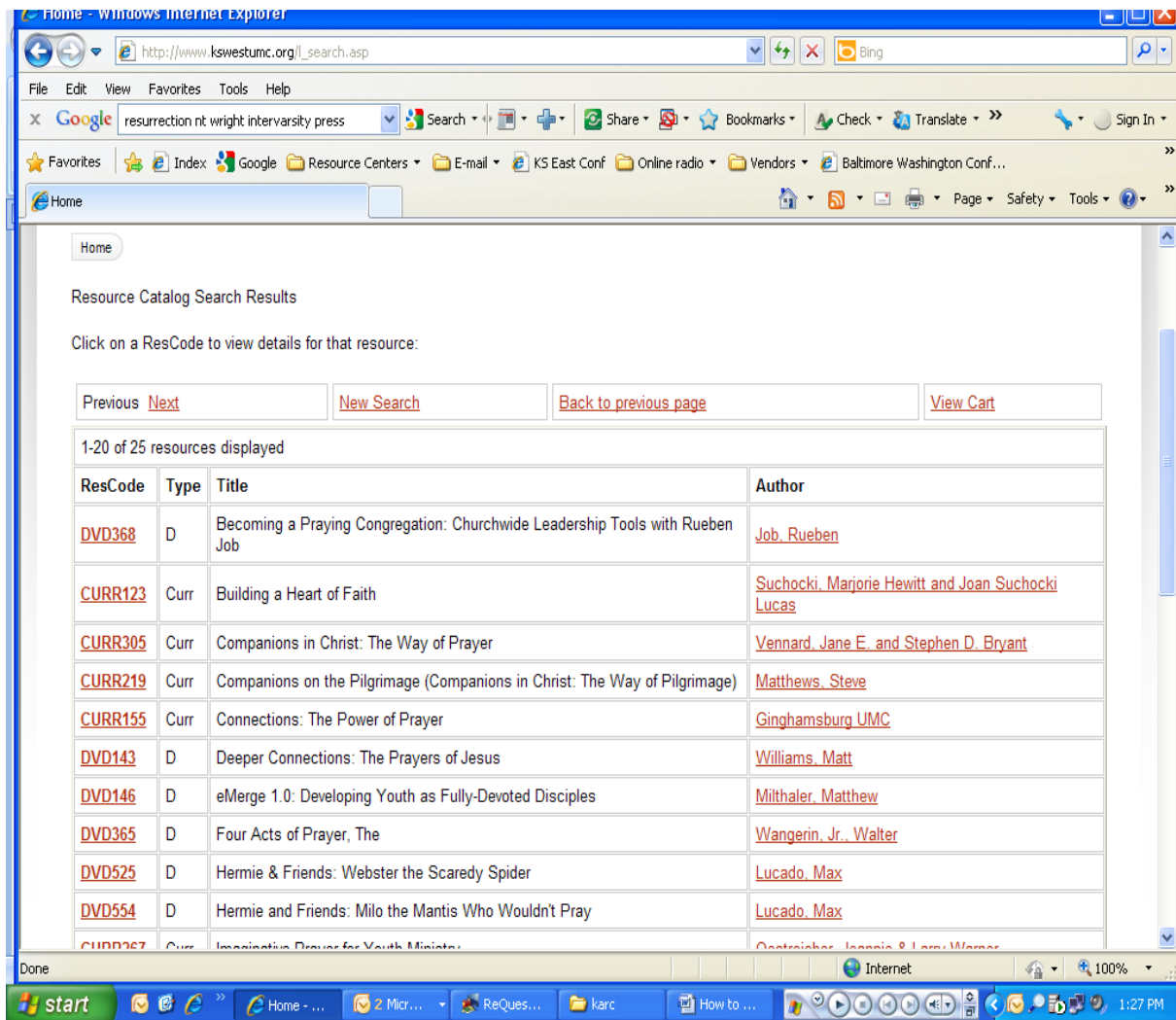

1. Access the Resource Center catalog at <http://www.kswestumc.org/catalog>



2. Search for resources by Title, Subject, Keyword or Author – easiest to do those than the others. Always search author by last name. Then click the “submit” button. You will then be directed to a screen with an alphabetical listing of the resources available.



3. Click on the Resource Number to bring up a description of the item. If this item is the one you want, you can click “add to cart” at the bottom of the screen.

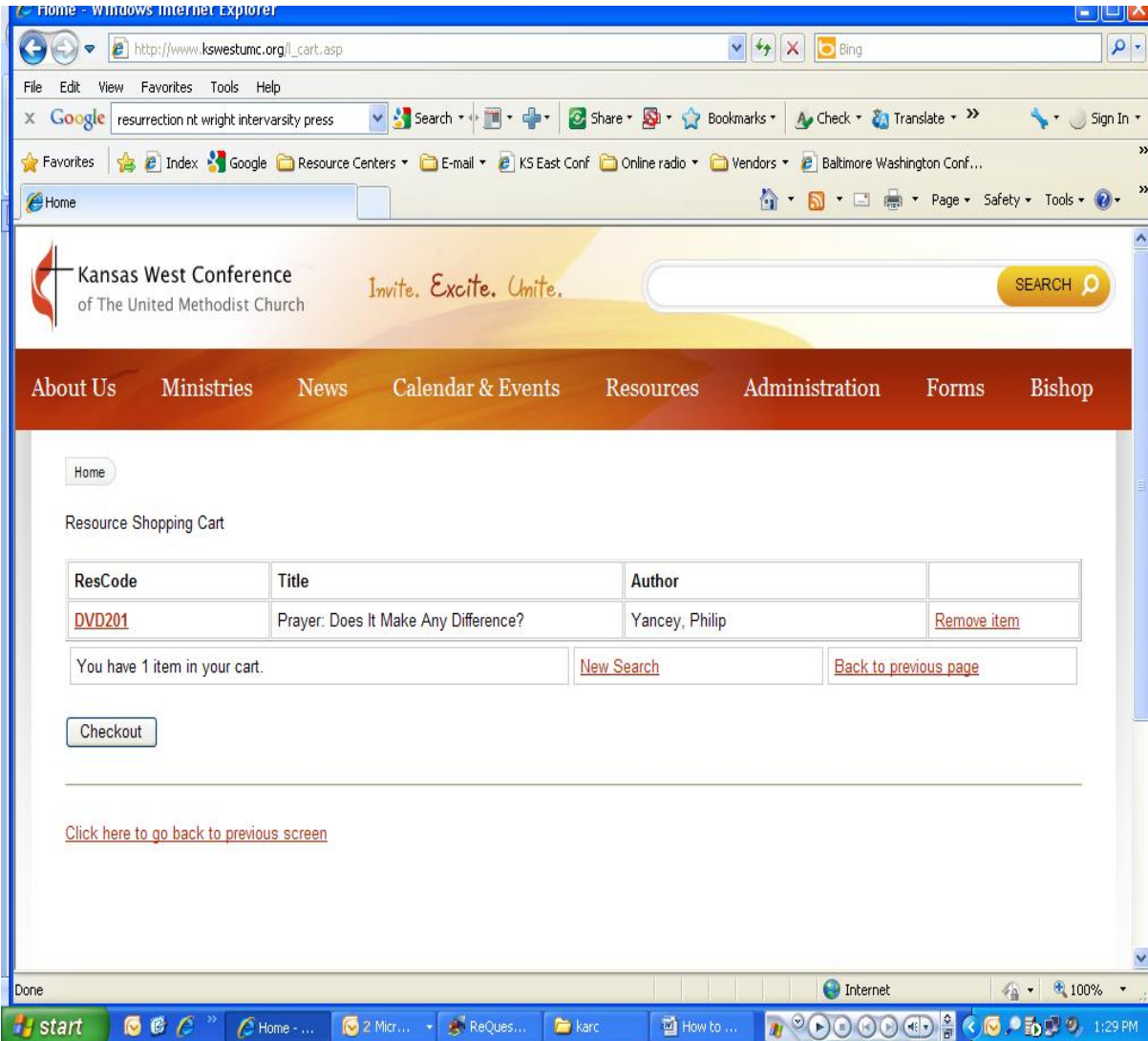

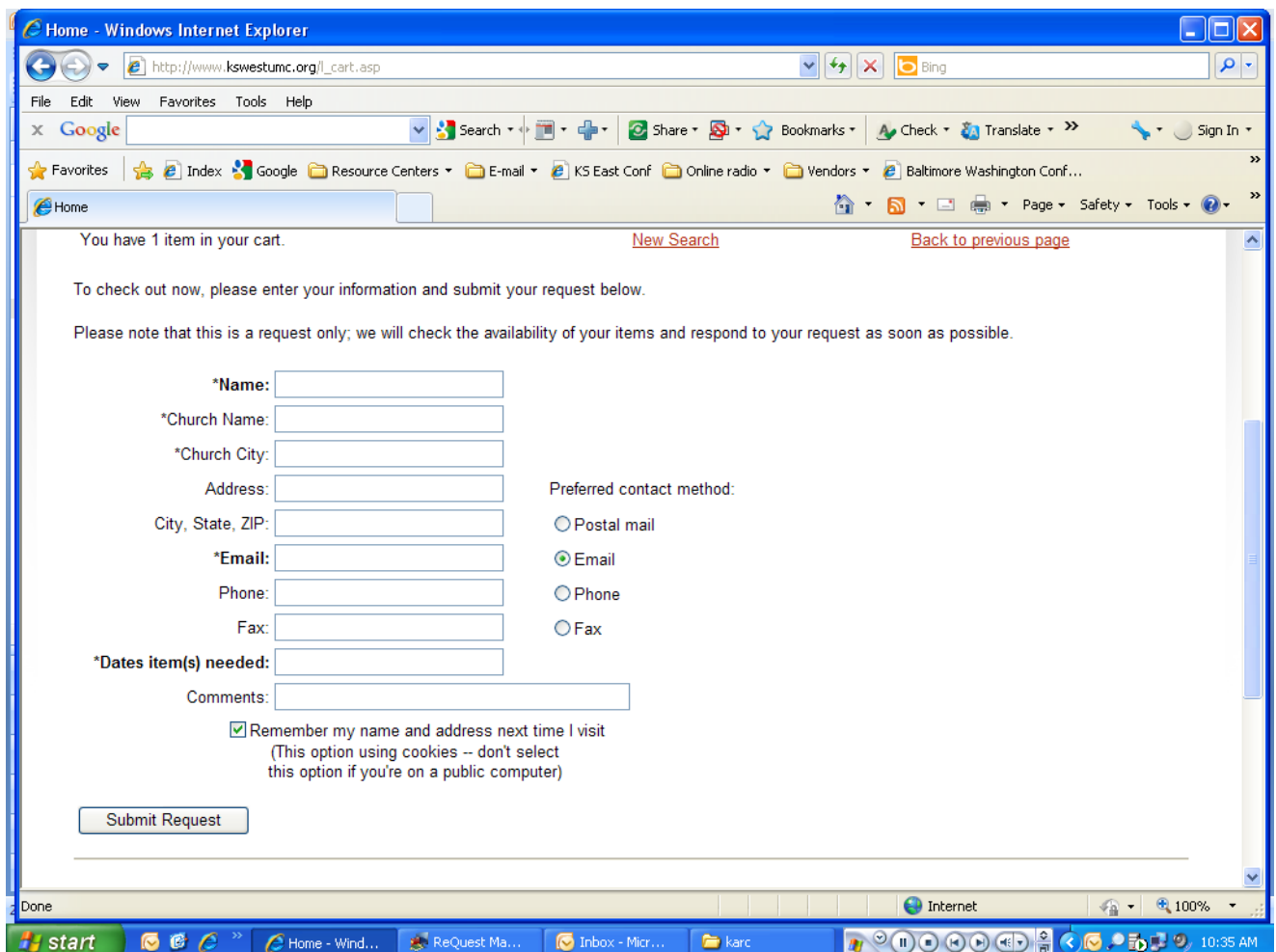
