

One Loaf

In Kansas World Communion Sunday is a celebration of two things. First and foremost, the statement of unity of all Christians in all places. Second, it provides an opportunity for those of us in wheat country, to celebrate the farms and farm families of our state as we remember the source of the Loaves we share.

ONE LOAF invites persons from all parts our conference, to bring wheat to Annual Conference. It will be ground into flour and returned to Annual Conference for members of the conference to use in their churches as they celebrate World Communion Sunday. Then the loaves on altars across our conference, become visible reminders of the unity Communion brings to us who share the Christian faith. As Paul wrote in his letter to the Corinthian Church; "Because there is one loaf, we, many as we are, are one body; for it is one loaf of which we all partake." (I Cor. 10:17 NEB)

To participate in donating wheat, bring a quart or more at registration time to the registration area.

To participate in receiving the flour for World Communion, simply pick up the number of packets (one packet for each loaf) needed.

You are welcome to invite other churches in your community to donate wheat and/or use the flour as they celebrate World Communion with us.
